Legal Framework

The Swiss Federal Act on the Licensing and Oversight of Auditors (AOA) and the Audit Oversight Ordinance (AOO) require approval by the Federal Audit Oversight Authority (FAOA) for all individuals providing audit services in Switzerland. Foreign audit professionals are required to demonstrate necessary knowledge of Swiss law (Art. 6 AOO). The following graphic schematically illustrates the requirements to become a licensed Swiss audit expert:

This preparation course addresses the Swiss law knowledge requirement, enabling foreign professionals to demonstrate understanding of Swiss legal principles relevant to audit practice. This encompasses key legal, tax and audit concepts. The course is not mandatory but provides an optimal basis for future practitioners and targeted exam preparation.


