



## **EXPERTsuisse Guide - Profile settings**

Opening the EXPERTsuisse.ch website <a href="https://expertsuisse.ch">https://expertsuisse.ch</a>

1. Please click on the login button (person icon) at the top right



- 2. Please write your registration email address in the email address field
- 3. Now click on Next




The system will now check whether you are already registered with us as a user

- 5. Click on Login




The dashboard of the EXPERTsuisse portal now appears as the start page


- 6. Now click on your initials
- 7. And then go straight to Profile settings



- 8. Here you can first customize your profile by clicking on the pencil next to the name, then continue as in point 10.
- 9. You also have the option of entering a contact e-mail address and your Linkedin Create a profile by clicking on the pen at



- 10. You can upload your own profile picture
- 11. After that, if you change something, you must fill in the mandatory fields
- 12. And finally confirm with Save changes




- 13. Now you can customize your contact address by clicking on the pencil. A window like the profile will then open where you can change your data and finally click on Save address
- 14. Click on the pencil next to Phone to enter and customize your phone number and confirm with Save changes
- 15. Click on the pencil next to Mobile to enter and customize your mobile number and confirm with Save changes
- 16. For the contact language, you can change your contact language by clicking on the penciland confirm with Save changes



## Continue with the billing address and delivery address

- 17. You can easily customize your billing address by clicking on the pencil
- 18. Under this point you can customize your delivery address



- 19. At the bottom you can define the visibility of your profile
- 20. Here you can see that the phone has active visibility, this is the case as soon as it is green, otherwise it is inactive
